WHEREAS, the City of Selma desires to apply for Youthbuild grant, which shows young people how to build new homes for people in need, and new lives for themselves; and


WHEREAS, Each year, youth who participate in Youthbuild receive a combination of classroom academic and job skills development and on-site training in a construction trade. With support from HUD, Youthbuild participants are able to put their newly acquired skills to good use rehabilitating and building housing for low-income and homeless people in their communities; and

WHEREAS, Youthbuild provides funding to public and private non-profit organizations, that include community-based organizations, community action agencies, state or local housing agencies, community development corporations, and any other entity including States, and units of general local government eligible to provide education and employment training; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Planning and Development, hereby request permission to use \$5,000 from the Grant Matching Funds Line Item (1.6006 100-9) to enter into an agreement with a consultant to assist in preparation of the Youthbuild Grant.




